More ways we can help

- We provide specialist assessment and rehabilitation for adults and children with neurological impairments or complex presentations.
- We provide detailed OT reports including recommendations for rehabilitation and equipment provision.
- We work at home, in the community, in school, further and higher education and in the workplace.
- We work with children and young people with special education needs (SEN) to support their education and development
- We can provide programmes to support sensory integration
- We provide vocational rehabilitation to support young people and adults into sustained employment
- We lead on assessing and providing specialist equipment and housing adaptation.
- We work closely with speech and language colleagues to support cognitive approaches for language and communication development and to ensure accessibility of Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC) devices.
- We provide advice and assessment of adapted vehicles.
- We work closely with physiotherapy and nursing colleagues to assess and advise on postural management including advising and provision of 24 hour postural support systems and safe ways of working with these.
- We assess moving and handling risk and provide individualised moving and handling advice, recommendations for suitable equipment and training, for families and carers, wherever this is required.
- We deliver bespoke training packages for family, care staff, schools and employers including Acquired Brain Injury awareness training and training in specialist equipment and applications.
